Following a review by the University System of Georgia, Interim Provost Linda Noble announced that Kennesaw State will continue its Culinary Sustainability & Hospitality (CSH) degree program. This means that all current students will be allowed to declare the CSH major and new students will be allowed to declare the major. Those students who have been waiting to move into the Integrative Studies program will be allowed to do so, following the completion of all proper requirements and procedures.

We are currently working to restore the program to its original mission as originally approved by the Board of Regents in 2013.

While the curriculum is in review and during this revision period, please note that there will be some restrictions on CSH course enrollment.

\* Declared CSH majors for Fall 2018, students of any major planning a December 2018 graduation, and students needing CSH courses for progression toward a Spring 2019 graduation will be allowed to take CSH courses.

\* Non-CSH majors enrolled in a Fall 2018 CSH course will be evaluated individually by our advising team about placement in these courses.

\* Decisions regarding enrollment in the Spring CSH course schedule will be made in early fall 2018.

We are dedicated to ensuring that these restrictions will not negatively impact a student's progression toward graduation. We encourage you to check with your academic advisor with any questions or concerns you may have and to ensure that you are on the right path to graduate.
